Story-telling. Old-fashioned story-tellers entertain visitors and encourage continuation of the story-telling art. Performances all day.

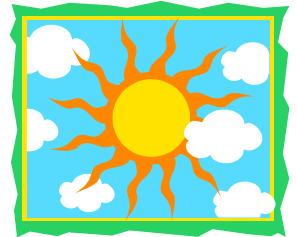
Marine Mammal Stranding Network. See how a dolphin is rescued in this mock stranding and rescue.

Be a partner with us and learn how you can help make our world a better place to live. You just might learn something and have a great time, too!

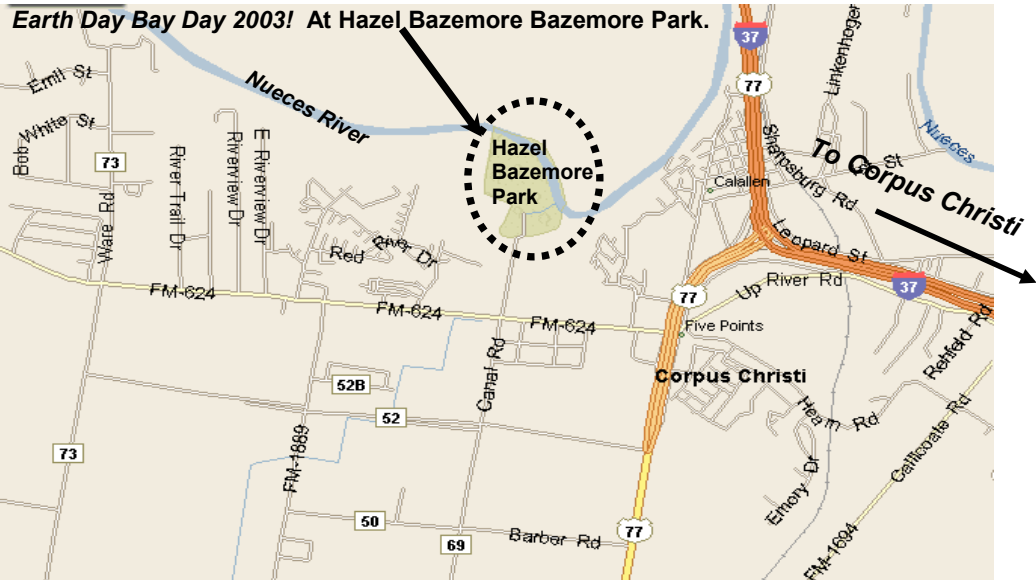
